Updates from SIS Coordinators and Committee Coordinators	Clare Giuffrida - Early Intervention SIS  See attached document from ILOTA that guided the development of the EIC and its bylaws. It is probably helpful to know that prior to the EIC's present organization the coalition was headed by the PT executive director, Colleen Flannery, who volunteered to act as the lead for the coalition as it was emerging. Coleen Flannery the ED for IPTA volunteered to host the EIC meetings and to act as the overall lead. However, other members of the coalition were uncomfortable with a discipline specific individual leading the coalition and turned to their associations for guidance. Previous to Colleen's leadership Benny Delgado previous president of IDTA was lead of the informal gathering of the associations on critical EI issues such as EI budget cutbacks, and proposed changes to the eligibility criteria for EI.  ILOTA past president Jim Hill indicated that there was a document drafted by all the associations, ILOTA, ISHA and IPTA that was developed to guide the three associations on forming a group from the three associations focused on one issue. IPTA indicated that the formation of a EI coalition as proposed in the coalition guidelines was not of interest to them but they did support the coalition and identified a representative. ISHA supported the formation of the EIC and proposed a lead and as ISHA had an EISIS similar to ILOTA's EI SIS the rep from EISIS for ISHA acted as the lead for ISHA in the EIC. The three original association leads for the EIC are no longer leads but the current leads were again appointed by the associations. IPTA does not have a EI SIS group but the lead PT for the coalition posts monthly updates and communicates directly with Colleen, IPTA's executive director. ISHA and ILOTA channel information about EI through different channels in their association.
